This facility is open year round for competitive, educational, recreational and fitness swimming. The facility features a 25-yard by 50-meter olympic size pool with two 1-meter diving boards and a 3-meter board. Spectator seating is available. The facility is handicap accessible.

Hours

General Facility Guidelines

General Information

Parents are required to watch their children and to assist in enforcing the policies for the safety and enjoyment of all patrons. All children under 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a paying adult.

Fitness Swim

During scheduled fitness swims, the pool is available for lap swimming and other fitness activities. Children will not be admitted into the facility during this time period unless engaging in some sort of structured physical exercise. No free play will be permitted during this time.

Swim Diapers

Swim diapers must be worn by infants and toddlers, and may be purchased at the front counter for \$1.75 each.

Flotation Devices

Children may wear U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices; however, they must be within arm's reach of a supervising adult at all times. No blow-up rafts or Styrofoam water noodles will be allowed. Facility staff reserves the right to restrict any flotation devices that are determined to be unsafe or improperly used.
