Park Improvements to City Cemeteries, Fort D, & park restrooms.

IMPROVE CITY CEMETERIES

CURRENT ISSUES

Maintenance Aging monuments and sites that need maintenance and renovation.	Roadways Deteriorating roadways and parking areas that need to be overlaid and repaired.	Entryways Deteriorating mortar on entryways and access ways that need to be replaced.
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PROJECT SCOPE

- Overlay existing roadways and parking areas for all cemeteries.
- Renovate deteriorating stone entryway to Old Lorimier and improve other entryways to New Lorimier and Fairmont cemeteries.
- Improve aging historical monuments.

PROJECT OUTCOMES

- ★ Improving deteriorating roadways and parking areas will make a more pleasing and safe visit to patrons of the cemeteries.
- ★ Proper maintenance of old monuments will help ensure the longevity of these historical stones and a part of Cape's history.

CONSTRUCTION COST ESTIMATE: \$250,000

IMPROVE FORT D

CURRENT ISSUES

Parking Lack of designated parking area.	Restrooms Lack of permanent restroom facility.	Security Inadequate security lighting with the location often the subject of vandalism.	Roofing WPA structure has been without a permanent roof for a number of years which is causing the entire structure to degrade.	Degradation Historic markers, access and pathways need to be renovated and have been degrading due to weather and vandalism.
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PROJECT SCOPE

- Determine site restrictions and opportunities to improve parking, vehicular, and pedestrian access.
- Install a roof over the existing WPA structure to protect the historic building.
- Construct a permanent restroom and pavilion for events and activities.
- Perform needed maintenance to existing walls and structure.
- Enhance historical interpretive panels and educational opportunities to increase park usage.

PROJECT OUTCOMES

- ★ Will ensure the longevity of this historical site and structure.
- ★ Increased lighting will provide for the safety and security of the area.
- ★ Overall improvements will make the park more attractive and usable for the public.
- ★ Create a more efficient area for programs and events.

CONSTRUCTION COST ESTIMATE: \$200,000



FORT D

ADD PARK RESTROOMS

CURRENT ISSUES

Quantity Not enough restroom facilities to comfortably accommodate outside program and event areas.	Rental Costs Annual rental costs for appropriate amount of portable toilets continues to increase.	Maintenance & Safety Portable toilets are difficult to maintain and users are often uncomfortable using them and often do not feel safe using one.	Aesthetics Portable toilets degrade the aesthetic appearance of a city park/facility often with an accompanying odor and are often vandalized.
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PROJECT SCOPE

- Build a minimum of five (5) permanent restroom facilities in planned locations throughout the park system.
- Examples would be Arena Park Trail Head, South parking lot near the Red House, Dennis Scivally Park, Indian Park, Osage Trail Head, and the Shawnee Park Trail Head.

PROJECT OUTCOMES

- ★ Decrease rental cost of portable toilets.
- ★ Improve aesthetics of the parks.
- ★ Improve access and usability.

CONSTRUCTION COST ESTIMATE: \$350,000
